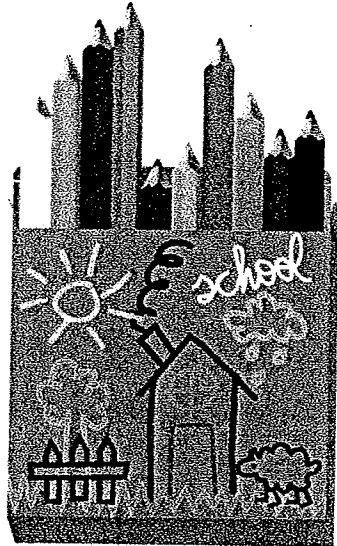

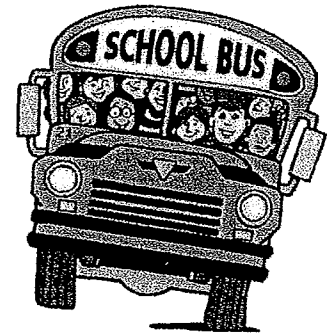

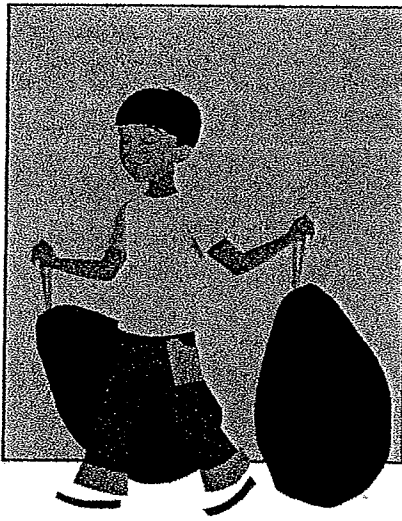


Pet Notes
